	White Space	There is enough white space throughout the design which helps reduce the cognitive load of visitors and it makes it much easier for users to segment and digest the information presented Consider improvements
	Call to Actions	Call to actions are missing on some pages and they are not easily distinguishable from the rest of the page

	Social Media Engagement	Each tweet gets retweeted 1.35 times on average and favorited 1.25 times on average. Posts on the LinkedIn page get just a few engagements. Better engagement rates could be achieved through promoted tweets and sponsored LinkedIn updates. (see LinkedIn account account analysis.pdf for a detailed twitter account analysis)
	Profile standardization	Your social media presence is consistent with your core messaging.
	Best practices	The content you share on social media channels is lacking promotional posts, which could lead to more traffic to your website. Tips: Develop a social media calendar and post when your followers are more active. Follow the golden ratio for content sharing - Golden Ratio – 30/60/10 - 30 percent owned content, 60 percent curated content and 10 percent promotional content. Promotional posts could be linked to specific landing pages. Creating a separate social media accounts in German is recommended.
